ShipServ Onboard is designed to make it easier to find the products and services you need.

This year's edition is completely digital. Everything can be found by using the search engine, found on the main screen. This will show results linked to supplier profiles, catalogs, advertisements, and product specification sheets.

A supplier profile contains general information about the supplier, including a company description, the categories of products and/or services they supply, the brands they sell, the locations/ports in which they are present or can cover, and more.

A supplier catalog contains a list of products, and is designed to facilitate the requisitioning process. Where possible, part number and description have been provided so that the item can be inserted directly onto a requisition.

An advertisement contains information supplied by the company exactly as they wish it to be seen.

A product specification sheet is generally editorial in nature. Space is allocated by the publisher and not paid for by the manufacturer. Advertising on a specification sheet is typically limited to the strip at the bottom of the page. A company may sponsor the strip, or ShipServ may sponsor the page.

Deck

Rope, chain, anchors, doors, hatches, winches, scaling tools.

Electric and Lights

Lamps, connectors, receptacles, switches, cable, batteries, fuses, and fixtures.

Valves, Hoses and Fittings

Valves, couplings, drains, strainers, fittings, pipe, hose, tubing, and lavatory plumbing.

Engineering

Items generally found below deck, as well as complex systems. Including bearings, seals, gaskets, level switches, thermometers, tank cleaning equipment, pumps, water treatment, blowers, HVAC, taps, dies, hand and power tools.

Safety, Navigation and Communications

Firefighting equipment, lifeboats and launches, lifeboat supplies, charts, VHF radios, alarm equipment, telecomms, personal protection, and medical.

Chemicals

Lubricants, greases, degreasers, cleaners, sealants, pipe repair, anti-corrosion, coatings, and anodes.

Cabin and Galley

Ovens, ranges, refrigerators, freezers, ice makers, fryers, food disposals, compactors, washers, dryers, mops, brooms, brushes, lavatory hardware, and cabin furnishings.

Chandlers and Marine Services

Companies that provide chandler, port-related services, logistics and other services.

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
